## **Guidelines For 2010**

### **Cross-country schoolings, camps, and clinics:**

All riding must be supervised by coaches, trainers, or instructors.

Coaches, trainers or instructors are persons who have ridden at or above the level at which the rider is schooling, and provides appropriate guidance.

All instructors are responsible for informing their students of all guidelines *before* their scheduled schooling day.

All riders, coaches, trainers, or instructors must sign a Meadows of Moorpark release form, and follow current USEA rules and guidelines for eventing.

All minors must have a parent or legal guardian sign the release form.  
Coach, trainer, or instructor's are not legal guardians. Release may be found on our website.

Fees for cross country schooling per day are: \$60 per horse/rider. Cash only. Personal Checks or credit cards will not be accepted.

Dressage arenas and practice stadium jumps are available for use during cross country schoolings. They are also available separately at \$ 25/day.

Pipe corrals are complimentary for day use, \$ 25 per overnight. Please clean them before you leave.

USEA approved cross country attire for both horse and rider are required.  
( Body protector vest, current USEA medical armband, field or dress boots, cross country helmet, etc.)
